Capacity fixed around today's assumptions

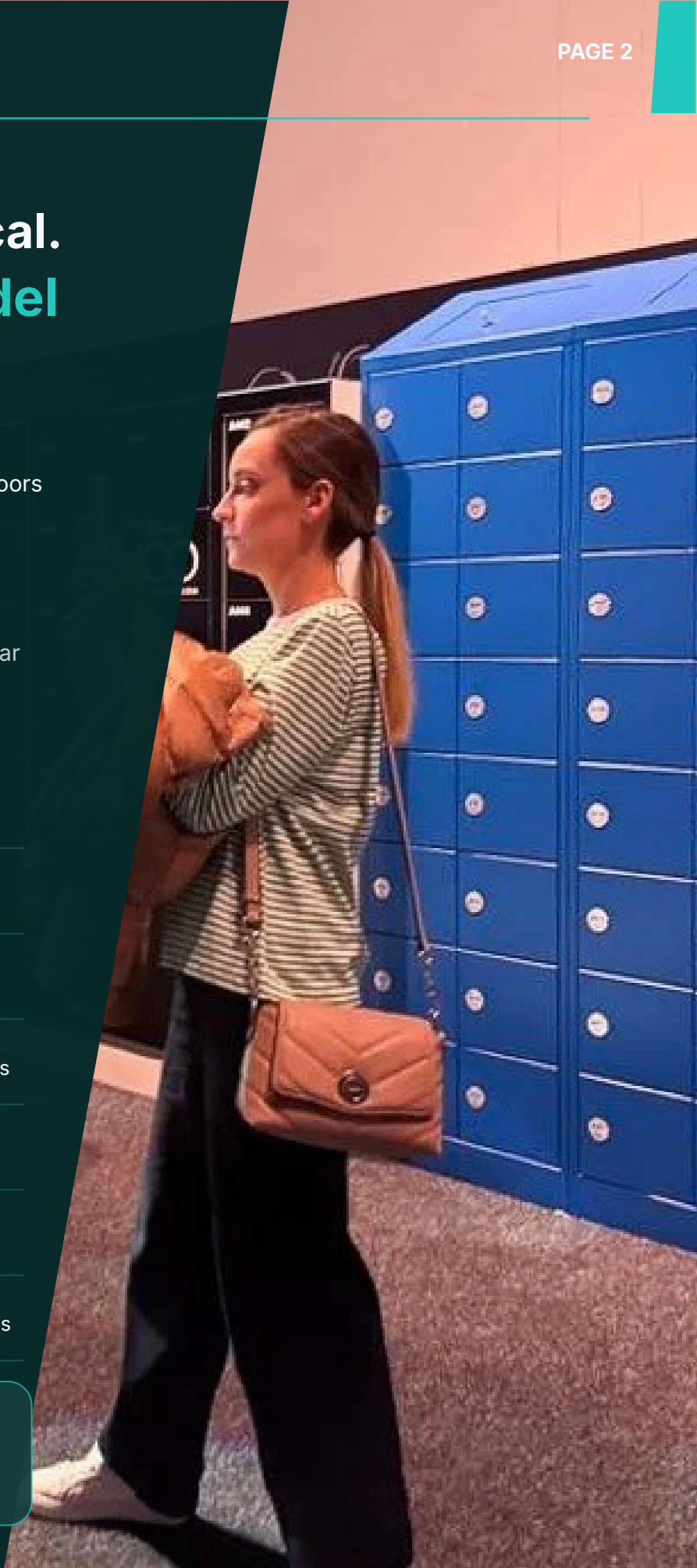


Future-ready projects start with architecture and operating model - then select the locker configuration.

The 7 Requirements of Future-Ready Leisure Lockers



1



Cloud-Managed

Central visibility and administration across locations.

2



Integration-Ready

Connect payment, retail, ticketing or loyalty journeys where required.

3



Flexible Access

Use QR, PIN, WebApp and workflows suited to each audience.

4



Observable

Provide usage, occupancy and activity data for decisions.

5



Scalable & Modular

Add capacity, mixed sizes or new locations without redesign.

6



Configurable

Switch between visitor storage, click & collect, VIP or staff workflows.

7



Supportable

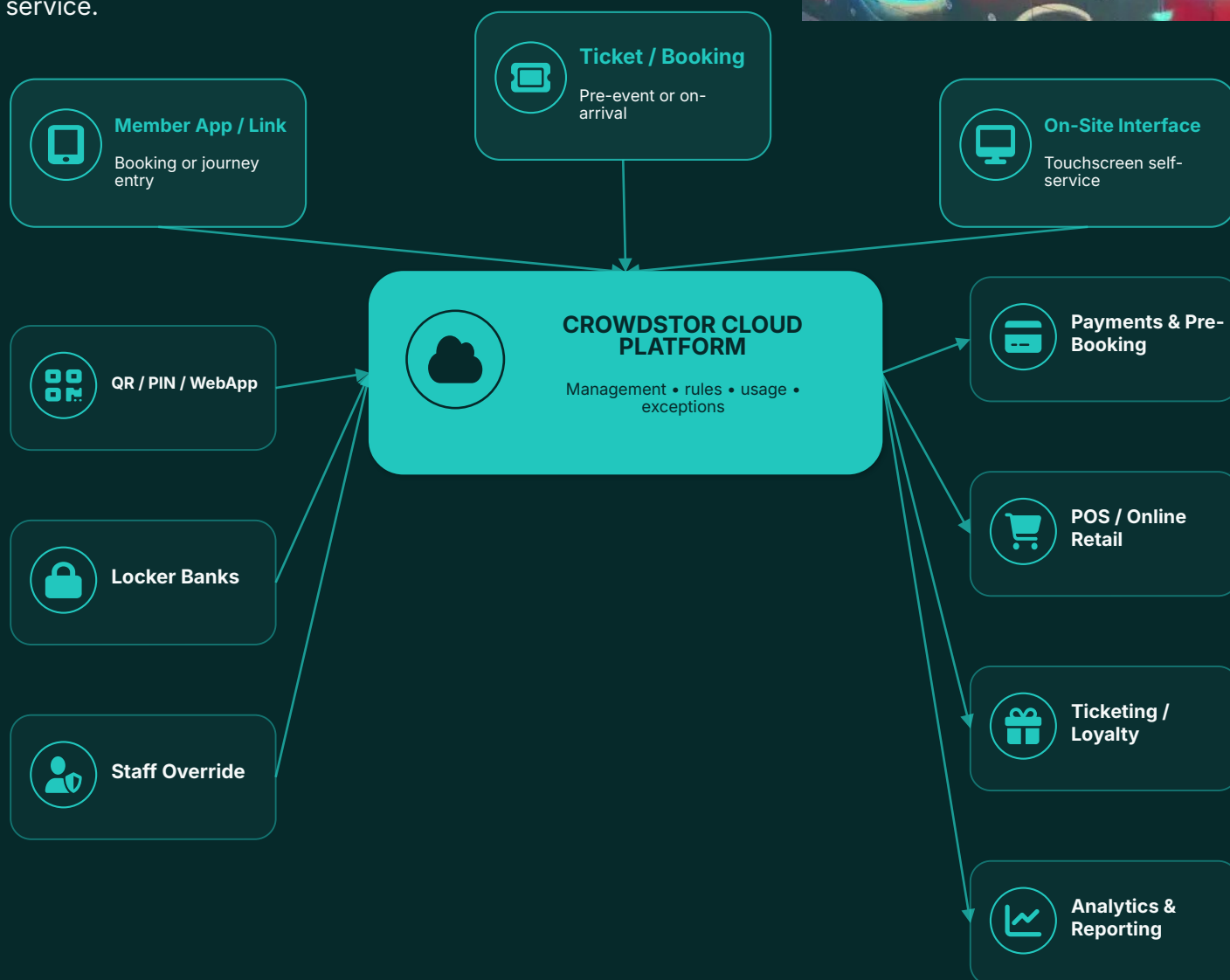
Clear exception handling, authorised overrides and repeatable site processes.

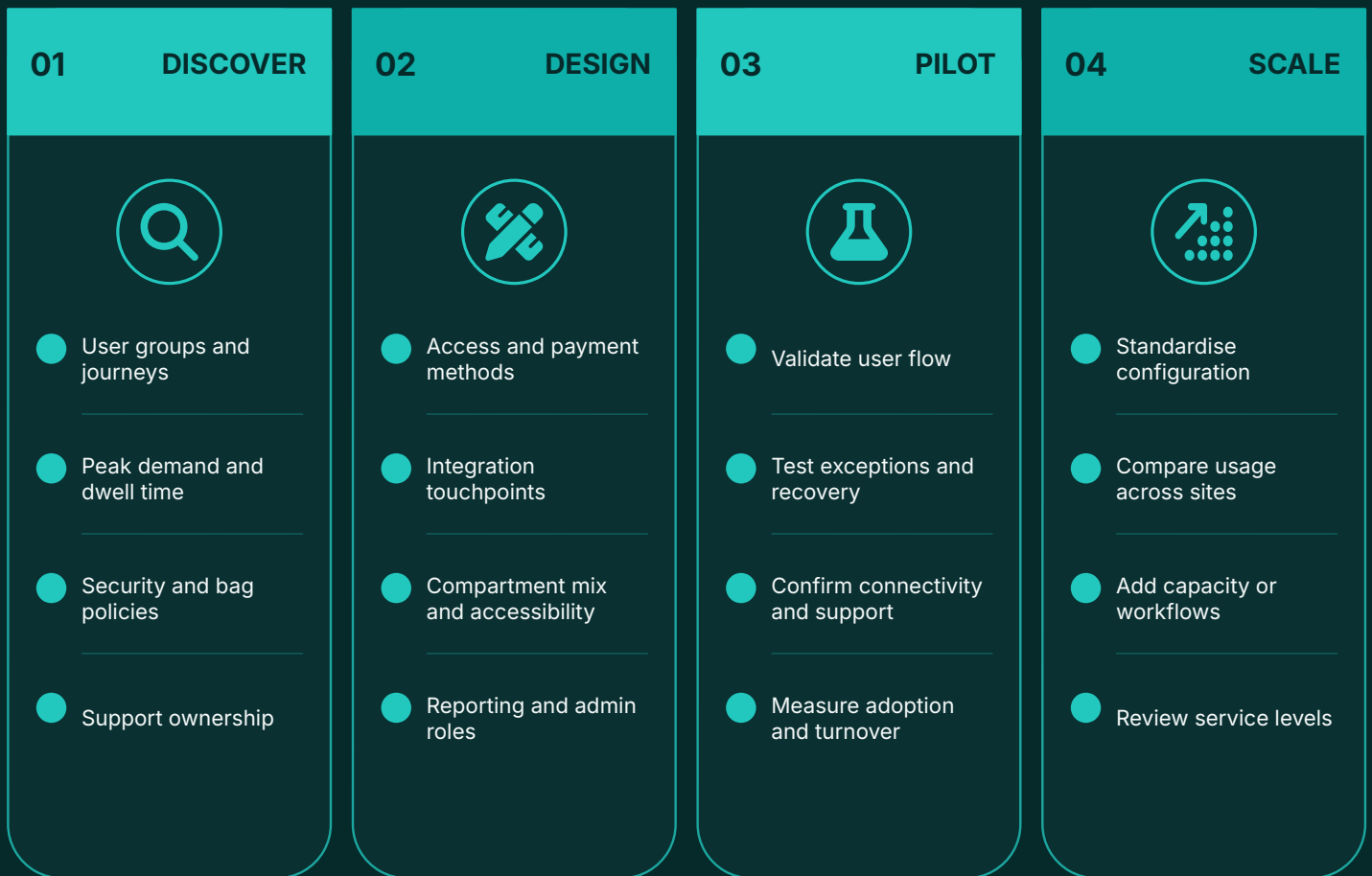
